Dear First Presbyterian Church Oostburg,

Imagine you are walking home and as you round the corner you look up—only to find that your house is destroyed or even gone! That is what happened to about 250 families in the village of Bulambuli in eastern Uganda. A mudslide swept through the village taking homes and possessions along with it.

A team of ten people from Campus Crusade for Christ Uganda visited the village from October 26th-28th this year and found that many families had lost not only their homes but also most of their earthly possessions. Access to the nearest medical clinic was cut off due to the mudslide, and even if they could have reached it, the clinic had little or no medicine.

Our team had enough care packages for 100 families that included a mosquito net to help prevent malaria (especially critical for young children), a hoe (most farming is done by hand), used clothing donated by Ugandans, and school supplies for children. The distribution was done at a church in the village. The team shared the gospel using personal evangelism and the Jesus film. Over 140 people indicated decisions for Christ. Please pray for the new believers.

Our team promised to come back and offer more help, including assistance for the 150 or so families that did not receive gifts. They plan to do more evangelism and help follow-up the new believers. Ugandan university students are expected to be a part of the working party. It will be a great opportunity for them to lend a hand and to develop a vision for helping transform society for Christ.

It costs about \$30 to provide a gift of a mosquito net, hoe and school supplies for a family. Our team would like to go back with 150 packages so that each family can receive one, making the total need \$4,500. Would you consider a year end gift to help the people of Bulambuli?

As we move into 2012 we also have personal needs including school fees for Brianna and Sophia and travel expenses as we plan to come home for furlough next year. Would you consider a year end gift to help meet these needs? Thank you for considering this.
